* Description of levels -

HONORS - Honor level courses are designed for students of superior ability who will be seeking admission to highly competitive colleges and universities. These courses proceed at a rate which will be intellectually challenging to the students. Honors courses entail a deeper and broader study of a subject area, thereby requiring more intense preparation for class and thus more homework.

ACADEMIC - Academic level courses are designed for students who are planning to attend a four-year college or university

GENERAL - General level courses are designed for students who are planning to enter the work force immediately upon graduation or those who will seek admission to colleges, technical schools, or other post-high school education.

BASIC - Basic level courses are designed for students who are functioning below grade level in the core academic areas. Only those students who have been identified as being in need of remediation will be placed in basic level courses.
